- THE POSITIONING AND GESTURES: THE COUPLE'S JOINED HANDS AND THE WOMAN'S SLIGHTLY RAISED DRESS ARE INTERPRETED BY SOME SCHOLARS AS REFERENCES TO MARRIAGE VOWS AND FERTILITY.

COMPOSITION AND USE OF LIGHT

VAN EYCK'S MASTERY OF LIGHT AND TEXTURE IS EVIDENT IN THE PORTRAIT'S COMPOSITION. THE NATURALISTIC LIGHT FLOODING THE ROOM HIGHLIGHTS THE INTRICATE DETAILS OF FABRICS, WOOD, AND GLASS. THE WAY LIGHT INTERACTS WITH SURFACES CREATES A SENSE OF DEPTH AND REALISM PREVIOUSLY UNSEEN IN PORTRAITURE.
