THE PLOT IN A NUTSHELL

MURAKAMI'S CHARACTERS FREQUENTLY GRAPPLE WITH FEELINGS OF LOSS AND LONGING, AND THIS NOVEL IS NO DIFFERENT. THE SEARCH FOR BELONGING AND UNDERSTANDING UNDERPINS MUCH OF THE NARRATIVE TENSION.

BLEND OF MYSTERY AND MAGICAL REALISM

THE RAT

A RECURRING FIGURE IN MURAKAMI'S EARLY WORKS, THE RAT IS BOTH A FRIEND AND A SYMBOL OF THE NARRATOR'S SUBCONSCIOUS FEARS AND DESIRES. THE SHEEP MAN

THE HOTEL AND OTHER KEY SETTINGS
