When students are not progressing or "responding," academically or behaviorally, to effective instructional conditions, RtI includes a functional assessment/problem solving process to determine the reason(s) for the lack of success, and the implementation of strategic through intensive interventions to help those students progress and be successful. At an operational level, RtI is often described as working within a flexible, three-tiered system that is guided by students' academic and behavioral outcomes. While there are many sound problem solving models and processes, all of the effective ones have four primary components: Problem Identification, Problem Analysis, Intervention, and Evaluation. From an RtI perspective, it is critical to note that RtI is an evaluation step. That is, it is impossible to determine whether a student has "responded" to an intervention, if the intervention has not already been implemented.
